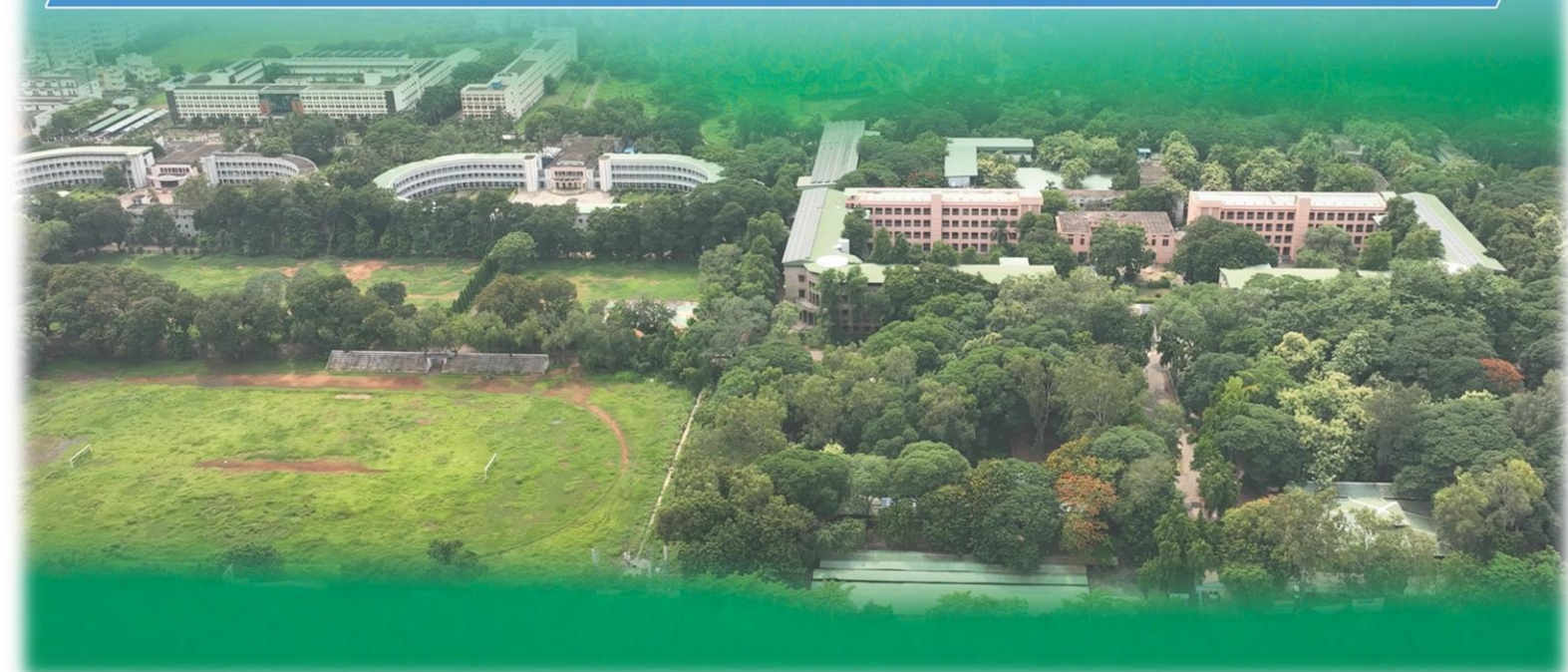

Statutory/Non-Statutory Committees - ALC

In any HEI, there are various statutory and non-statutory committees that play vital roles in governance, administration, and academic affairs.

Here is a list of common statutory and non-statutory committees at ALC:

Statutory Committees

Statutory committees are mandated by law or regulatory bodies, and their formation and functions are defined by statutes or legal guidelines.

Statutory Committees are legally required and have specific roles defined by regulatory bodies.

Governing Body (Board of Governors/Trustees)

The highest authority responsible for overall management and administration.

Academic Council

Responsible for academic policies, curriculum, and academic standards.

Finance Committee

Manages financial affairs, including budget approvals and audits.

Planning and Monitoring Board

Oversees development plans, resource allocation, and institutional performance.

Board of Studies

Formulates and reviews curriculum and academic content for specific departments or faculties.

Research and Development Committee (Centre For Continuous Learning and Research)

Promotes and oversees research activities and initiatives.

Examination Committee

Ensures smooth conduct of examinations and related processes.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Monitors and ensures the quality of education and institutional processes.

Grievance Redressal Committee

Addresses grievances of students, staff, and faculty.

Anti-Ragging Committee

Prevents and addresses incidents of ragging in the institution.

Non-Statutory Committees at ALC

Non-statutory committees are formed based on the institution's internal policies and needs. They are not mandated by law but play crucial roles in supporting the institution's operations and governance.

Non-Statutory Committees are created based on institutional needs and internal policies, providing additional support for various aspects of institutional functioning.

Disciplinary Committee

Handles disciplinary issues involving students, staff, and faculty.

Library Committee

Manages library resources and policies.

Calendar Committee

To plan, develop, and coordinate the academic calendar, ensuring efficient scheduling of events, holidays, and academic activities within the institution.

Anti-Ragging Committee

To prevent and address incidents of ragging, ensuring a safe and respectful environment for all students within the institution.

Internal Complaints Committee

To address and resolve complaints of sexual harassment within the institution, ensuring a safe and respectful environment for all members.

Centre for Equal Opportunities

To promote and ensure inclusivity and equality within the institution by addressing discrimination, supporting diversity, and providing equal access to resources and opportunities for all members of the community.

Admissions Committee

Oversees admission policies and processes.

Placement Committee

Facilitates student placements and industry interactions.

Cultural Committee

Organizes cultural events and activities.

Sports Committee

Promotes and organizes sports activities and facilities.

Alumni Association Committee

Engages with alumni and coordinates alumni activities.

Student Welfare Committee

Addresses student welfare issues and initiatives.

Counselling Cell

To support the mental and emotional well-being of students by providing professional counseling services and guidance on personal, academic, and psychological issues.

Placement and Career Guidance Cell

To facilitate student career development by providing job placement services, career counseling, and guidance on employment opportunities and skill development.

Ethics Committee

Ensures ethical standards in research and academic activities.

Women's Cell/Committee Against Sexual Harassment

Addresses issues related to sexual harassment and promotes gender sensitivity.

Examinations Committee

Suggesting body to Controller of Examinations in forming the rules and regulations of the examination related matters

Extension Services

Looks after the activities of NCC/NSS/NGC/ALERT-ALANA/AICUF,

Press Committee

To maintain the relations with media and to promote the activities through the media

Committee for People with Special Needs

To look after the needs of Visually and Physically handicapped students

Malpractice Committee

To monitor the malpractice cases and during the examinations and to suggest the actions to be taken, if they found with unwanted material during examinations

Canteen Committee

To oversee the management and operation of the institution's canteen, ensuring the provision of hygienic, nutritious, and affordable food to students and staff.
