

#### 1. WORLD DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOUR:

On the commemoration of the World Day Against Child Labour, the ALC Extension Wing ALANA and NSS Units collaborated to host an insightful awareness program for Degree students on the 12th of June 2023. This significant event took place at the PG Seminar Hall in partnership with Don Bosco Navjeevan Bala Bhavan. The International Labour Organization (ILO) declared June 12 as the World Day Against Child Labour in 2002, aiming to heighten awareness about this pressing issue. Consequently, the World Day Against Child Labour is annually observed on June 12th.



Sri. Bargav Ram, a distinguished Member of the Child Welfare Committee in NTR District, graced the program as the Chief Guest. He delivered a compelling message emphasizing that every child under 14 years old possesses the right to education. Sri. Ram urged attendees to support and motivate children who have dropped out of school to resume their education.

He highlighted that various factors, such as poverty, orphanhood, single-parent households, parental ill health, and runaway situations, contribute to child labour. Sri. Ram earnestly requested all students to remain vigilant and, if they encounter instances of child labour, either encourage the children to enroll in school or report the information to the toll-free child-line at 1098.

The program witnessed the presence of esteemed individuals, including Rev. Fr. G. Kiran SJ, Vice Principal; Rev. Fr. N. Ratna Kumar, Executive Director of Navjeevan Balabhavan; Mr. Shekar, Project Manager at Neethodu Vekasakendram; Mr. R. John, Extension Coordinator; NSS Programme Officers Dr. Samuel Dayakar, Sri. K.

Prakasa Rao, Dr. K. Shekar, Dr. Suresh, Mr. D. Elisha, and numerous participating students.

Their collective involvement underscored the importance of addressing and combatting child labour through collaborative efforts.

#### 2. ANTI DRUG-ABUSE RALLY:

To foster greater awareness among the general public and college students, the Extension Wing ALANA and NSS units, in collaboration with Don Bosco Navjeevan Bala Bhavan Vijayawada, orchestrated a purposeful rally on the 22nd of June 2023.

The route spanned from ALC College to Machavaram Police station, traversing through Veterinary Colony and Arul Nagar.



The inaugural moment of the rally was marked by Rev. Fr. G.A.P. Kishore, SJ, Principal of ALC, who waved the flag, officially commencing the procession.

Notable figures such as Rev. Fr. Santiyagu Thomas, Provincial of Navjeevan Balabhavan, Rev. Fr. Ratna Kumar, Director of Navjeevan Bala Bhavan, Mr. Shekar, Program Manager at Navjeevan Bala Bhavan, along with NSS Programme officers and students from degree, postgraduate, and intermediate levels actively participated in the rally.

Their collective efforts extended beyond the mere physical demonstration, as they fervently advocated slogans against drug abuse, emphasizing the imperative message of saying no to drugs and promoting a drug-free environment.

#### **3. ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON IMPLEMENATATION STRATEGIES &** FUTURE PLANNING FOR SC/ST SUB-PLAN:

A comprehensive one-day workshop addressing the crucial aspects of implementation strategies and future planning for the SC/ST sub-plan was thoughtfully organized by the Dalit Bahujan Resource Center. The enriching event took place at Hotel Sinduri on

the 11th of July 2023, attracting participation from state-level delegates representing various NGOs and institutions. Among the esteemed participants were Rev. Fr. AXJ Bosco, SJ, a distinguished former Provincial and committed Dalit activist, as well as Mr. R. John, Extension Work Coordinator, both of whom actively engaged in the program. Their insightful contributions added valuable perspectives to the discourse on empowering marginalized communities.



#### 4. SWACHH BHARAT CLEANLINESS DRIVE:

In the spirit of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan initiative, as part of the ALANA Extension program, students from the first year of the Degree program actively engaged in a Campus Cleanliness Drive on the 03.08.2023.



This endeavor not only injected fresh enthusiasm into the participants but also bolstered their commitment to the cause.

The initiative effectively conveyed a crucial message: the imperative need to preserve cleanliness in our surroundings and abstain from polluting the environment with plastic and dry waste. Volunteers, in addition to their efforts in cleaning, took the extra step of trimming bushes to further enhance the tidiness of the campus. The collective involvement of the first-year Degree students, alongside the dedicated participation of Mr. R. John, the Extension Coordinator, significantly contributed to the success of the program.

#### 5. NUTRITION SUPORT PROGRAM FOR HIV / AIDS & TB PATIENTS:

On August 5, 2023, an ALANA - MANNA Extension program, specifically a nutrition support program, was conducted at the Multipurpose Hall for People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA) and TB patients. Rev. Fr. Raju, SJ, the Vice Principal, graced the event and emphasized the importance of utilizing the regular ration provided by ALC along with a healthy diet to bolster the immune system.



Additionally, nutrition supplements comprising five different fiber and iron-rich provisions were distributed to 110 PLHA and TB patients. The program saw the participation of Mr. Yakobu from Navjeevan Balabhavan as well as Mr. R. John, the Extension Coordinator, along with DOVE Student Volunteers.

#### 6. SEMINAR ON GENDER EQUALITY:

As part of our College Extension program, ALERT organized a seminar on Gender Equality in collaboration with CITRA (Centre for Information, Training, Research, and Action) Secundrabad, on the 18.08.2023. The seminar featured the participation of Transgender members from the Swetha Transgender Welfare Society of Chilakaluripet.

The engagement of students was notable, as they actively took part and dispelled prevalent myths surrounding Transgender individuals in society. Ms. Sujatha, a representative from the Swetha Transgender Welfare Society, delivered an outstanding speech addressing the contemporary challenges faced by the Transgender community. She urged the present generation of youth not to hastily make decisions to become transgender, emphasizing the importance of treating Transgenders with equal respect, as they are also human beings.

The event saw the presence and participation of key figures, including Rev. Fr. Yesuratnam, SJ (Director of CITRA), Rev. Fr. Rayappa SJ (Head of the Department of Visual Communication), Mr. R. John (Extension Coordinator), and students from both the first and second years.

#### 7. NUTRITION SUPORT PROGRAM FOR HIV / AIDS & TB PATIENTS:

On October 10, 2023, an ALANA - MANNA Extension program focused on nutrition support was held at the Multipurpose Hall for People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA) and TB patients. Mr. R. John, the Extension Work Coordinator at ALC, delivered a talk on maintaining a healthy nutrition diet to strengthen the immune system.



Alongside the talk, nutrition supplements containing five different fiber and iron-rich provisions were distributed among 105 PLHA and TB patients. The event was attended by Mr. Madhu, Project Manager from ARHEDS TI NGO, and Mr. R. John, the Extension Coordinator, in addition to DOVE Student Volunteers.

#### 8. ALANA – PILLALA PANDUGA

On November 14, 2023, Andhra Loyola College's Extension wing, through the ALANA program, extended invitations to children from Vijayawada Municipal Schools and slums, collaborating with local NGOs such as Yesupadam Charitable Society, DBRC, and Navjeevan Bhalabhavan.

The event took place at the College's Hockey and Football grounds, with the participation of Rev. Fr. Dr. G.A.P. Kishore SJ, Principal, and Mr. K. Ajay Kumar, a retired IRS Officer representing NGOs.

Mr. K. Ajay Kumar emphasized the health benefits of sports, encouraging the children to stay physically active as it aids in concentration during studies. He commended ALC's management for organizing the "Pillalapanduga" event. The program featured various sports and games organized by student volunteers for primary and high school students, including running races of different distances, volleyball, coconut breaking, musical chairs, and tug of war.



Prizes were awarded to the winners, and the event was attended by 300 school children, student volunteers, NGO representatives, and Mr. R. John, the Extension Coordinator.

# 9. AWARENESS PROGRAM ON NUTRITION CARE FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH HIV / AIDS:


Under college Extension programme ALANA-MANNA Mr. R. John, the Extension Work Coordinator ALC, was extended an invitation to present a lecture on Nutrition Care for individuals living with HIV/AIDS at ARHEDS (Adarsha Rural Health & Economic Development Society) in Gandhi Nagar, Vijayawada, on the 21st of November 2023.



During his presentation, Mr. John delved into the significance of a nutritious diet to enhance immunity, emphasizing the consumption of iron-rich foods such as jaggery, millets, flattened rice, and red gram. The participants, including Mr. Madhu (Project Manager), Ms. Asha (Coordinator), Mr. K. Jhasua Program Manager Yesupadam Charitable Society, representatives from Jeevana Rekha Mahila Sangam, and NGO staff, actively engaged in the program. The audience comprised Peer Educators and Outreach Workers actively involved in the Targeted Intervention project, funded by the Andhra Pradesh State AIDS Control Society (APSACS), specifically focused on Female Sex Workers.

#### 10. NUTRITION SUPORT PROGRAM FOR HIV / AIDS & TB PATIENTS:

In light of the annual World AIDS Day observed on December 1st, the Extension division of ALC arranged a Nutrition support initiative under ALANA-MANNA on December 15th, 2023, held at the Multipurpose Hall for People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA) and TB patients. Rev. Fr. G.A.P. Kishore SJ, Principal, Mr. Kiran Kumar, District Program Manager (DAPCU) and Ms. Renuka, President of Adharsha Welfare Society for PLHA, graced the occasion.



Rev. Fr. G.A.P. Kishore SJ, Principal, highlighted the significance of utilizing the standard rations provided by ALC along with a nutritious diet to enhance the immune system. Furthermore, nutritional supplements containing five distinct fiber and iron-rich provisions were distributed to 100 PLHA and TB patients. The event witnessed the involvement of Mr. Yakobu Outreach Coordinator from Navjeevan Balabhavan as well as Mr. R. John, the Extension Coordinator, alongside DOVE Student Volunteers.

#### 11. ALERT – TRIBAL EXPOSURE PROGRAMME:

As part of our College ALERT Extension program, our first-year degree students volunteered to visit LITDS Katukapally from December 27 to December 30, 2023. They explored tribal villages to gain exposure to tribal life as part of the program. Additionally, our students organized awareness programs on health, sanitation, combating alcoholism, preventing child marriages, and promoting children's education through skits and songs.



These programs were conducted in Ramachandrapuram, Balimela, Katukapalli, Maddigudem, as well as among the Guttikoya and Konda Reddy tribes. Mr. R John, the Coordinator of Extension Activities, supervised and coordinated the entire program alongside the student volunteers from LITDS Kakutapally.

# 12. ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCIENCE LABORATORY FOR TRIBAL SCHOOL CHILDREN:

During our College ALERT Extension initiative, we discovered a lack of proper science lab equipment, including apparatus, chemicals, and acids, at the Tribal

school within LITDS, Katukapally. Our student volunteers stepped in to conduct science experiments in front of the school children, raising awareness about identifying acids and basic elements relevant to their studies. Following their presentation, a demonstration session was held with 8th and 9th class students, showcasing the experiments in more detail. The program was attended by Rev. Fr. Augustin SJ, Head Master of Aroope High School, Rev. Fr. Prasanth SJ, Director of LITDS, student volunteers, and Mr. R. John.

# 13. INVITED TALK ON "ETHICAL DILEMMAS AND SOCIETAL RESPONSIBILITIES ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING":

he Extension Wing of ALC organized an invited talk titled "Ethical Dilemmas and Societal Responsibilities on Human Trafficking" on February 9, 2024, at the PG Seminar ALC. Rev. Sr. Sahaya Mary, Head of the Department of Social Work at Maris Stella College, was the Guest Speaker, alongside Mr. A. Ramesh, District Coordinator of the Child Rights Advocacy Foundation Krishna District, and Rev. Fr. M. Sahayaraj SJ, Correspondent of ALC, who participated in the program.



## 2023-2024

#### **1. WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY:**

In commemoration of World Environment Day on 05/06/2023, our College NSS Units meticulously orchestrated a Plastic Waste Collection drive. A comprehensive initiative, the drive successfully separated 15 kilograms of plastic waste from the dry waste, ensuring proper disposal and creating heightened awareness on the imperative

practice of waste segregation among NSS Volunteers. This proactive step was taken in acknowledgment of the adverse impact our environment faces, exacerbated by the harmful smoke and dust emanating from indiscriminate waste dumps.



Within the program, the esteemed NSS Program officers, including Dr. A. Samuel Dayakar, Dr. K. Shekar, Mr. D. Elisha, Sri. K. Ram earnestly requested all students to remain vigilant and, if they encounter instances of child labour, either encourage the children to enroll in school or report the information to the toll-free child-line at 1098.

Ratna Kumar, Executive Director of NavjeevanBalabhavan; Mr.Shekar, Project Manager at NeethoduVekasakendram; Mr. R. John, Extension Coordinator; NSS Programme Officers Dr. Samuel Dayakar, Sri. K. PrakasaRao, Dr. K. Shekar, Dr. Suresh, Mr. D. Elisha, and numerous participating students. Their collective involvement underscored the importance of addressing and combatting child labour through collaborative efforts.

#### AMRIT KALASH YATRA:


